Type of Scholarship: Merit and Service based

Amount of Award: \$1,000.00

Number Available: 1

Years Eligible: Senior enrolled full-time and in good standing (apply in your junior year)

Selection Criteria:

- Commitment to and participation in documented community service projects
- Minimum 2.80 cumulative overall grade point average
- Good Attendance
- Financial need as determined by FACTS

Additional Requirements:

- Standard Application materials and requirements
- Recipients must provide documentation of at least 20 hours of community service during the course of the student's junior and senior year.
- Attendance for at least 170 days of the school year.

Award Details:

- The scholarship award/funds will be transferred directly into the Andrean student tuition account. No funds will be awarded directly to the student.
